
The dates are May 28 - 30, so plan your May bidding for those days off!

MINUTES FROM THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN AIRLINE PILOTS

ISA + 21

May 29, 1979

The meeting was called to order by President Claudia Jones at 12:00 at the Diplomat Hotel in Hollywood, Florida. Claudia welcomed all the members and stated that our purpose in meeting was to establish a network of communication between the women airline pilots of the world. Claudia explained that HALP (Husbands of Airline Pilots) was formed at our meeting last year in Las Vegas. HALP also includes boyfriends, consorts, gigolos and anyone else you care to bring. All of the ISA officers were introduced and then the members in the room introduced themselves and told everyone what position and equipment they were flying.

Vice President Beverly Bass thanked everyone for coming and gave a special thanks to the Diplomat Hotel for the cocktail party. She also thanked American Airlines for giving us the terrific breakfast at our meeting.

Terry London Rinehart gave the minutes to last years meeting.
