



Other Topics to Incorporate in your Presentation

- Other careers in aviation for those not interested in being a *pilot*
 - Almost every career field at the airlines: Pilot, FAs, Doctor, Lawyers, Marketing, Business managers, Chief, etc.
- Share aviation-related Guinness Book of World Record accomplishments
- Talk about sports athletes – show what airplanes they own/fly. Which celebrities are pilots themselves
- Talk about a legend like Amelia Earhart or other notable pilots (females) in aviation
- Talk about a normal day from the time you get up to the time you get to the hotel or back home
 - Take camera along for a trip – show “A Day in the Life Photos”
- How many miles you flew last year/ hours spent in the air so far = how many days does that equate?
- Pick close landmark that is about 7-8 miles away that students are familiar with. Your plane only takes *one minute to fly there* at cruise speed
- How to navigate / how to check the weather
- What were you like when you were little? Who gave you your inspiration to be a pilot?
- Females are moms and grandmothers
- Tell a cool flying story
- Encourage students to ask to meet the pilots on their next flight
- Some people go to college for to be a pilot, that's not required - some people are in pilots just for fun as well!
- How to prepare your knowledge/personality skills for this career - mental math, mechanical minds, calm during emergencies, no visible tattoos, no police record, etc.
