



COVID-19 Guidelines

Stay home if you are sick.

- Stay home if you have been currently diagnosed with COVID-19 (or have symptoms of COVID-19), if you are waiting for COVID-19 test results, or if you may have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.

Maintain good hygiene.

- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Hand sanitizer stations and individual spray bottles will be available.

Social Distancing and Masks

- It is mandatory to wear masks in public settings and when around people who do not live in your household.
- It is mandatory to wear a mask when interacting with other people indoors to minimize the risk of transmitting the virus.
- Wearing masks is most important when social distancing is difficult.
- Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from people who do not live in your household. Be particularly mindful in areas where it may be harder to keep this distance, such as check-in areas, parking lots, and routes of entry and exit.
- Arrive to the event early or at off-peak times to avoid crowding and congested areas.
- Avoid using restroom facilities at high traffic times.
- Select seating or determine where to stand based on the ability to keep 6 feet of space from people who don't live in your household, including if you will be eating or drinking.

Limit contact with commonly touched surfaces or shared items

- Avoid any self-serve food or drink options, such as buffets, salad bars, and condiment or drink stations. Use grab-and-go meal options, if available.
- Use touchless garbage cans or pails, and cashless payment options when possible.
- Use disposable food service items including utensils and dishes, if available.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer immediately before eating food or after touching any common surfaces like hand railings, payment kiosks, door handles, and toilets.
